8. Teen Center renovation completed

The Niles Teen Center in November added more than 1,000 square-feet to its facility at Golf Mill Shopping Center, doubling in size.

The \$50,000 renovation was paid for by contributions from local businesses and free labor and supplies provided by Home Depot.

The improvements to the center included an additional study room and new computer lab.

"There's so much more space for the kids and there's quite a bit less bickering," Teen Center Director Mark Williams said after the grand reopening. "Now that I have this bigger space, I'll be able to schedule much more substantive programs and have more speakers and things like that."
