Car Wash Benefits Teen Center, Charity

Heavy rains didn't turn away a few local youngsters from working Saturday's Niles Teen Center car wash at Golf Mill Shopping Center.

Still, Teen Center Director Mark Williams hopes the turnout will be better (and drier) this weekend, rescheduling the charity event for this Saturday.

The Teen Center is raising money, half of which will be donated to Habitat for Humanity and half of which will help fund the center.

Last Saturday's car wash saw seven autos washed and seven teens work the event. It was far fewer cars and teens to wash them than Williams anticipated. He said he blamed the weather and anticipates a larger turnout this Saturday. The center has 300 registered teens in sixth and 12th grades. The center, located in Golf Mill, is a place teens can go after school to work on homework or participate in activities such as game tournaments and movie nights.
