

VILLAGE OF NILES ANNOUNCES NEW DEPUTY VILLAGE MANAGER

Village of Niles Deputy Village Manager Hadley Skeffington-Vos has announced her resignation from the Village, effective January 7, 2022. Village Manager Joe La Margo, in consult with the Board of Trustees, has named current Assistant to the Village Manager Kathy Thake as Skeffington-Vos's permanent replacement.

Skeffington-Vos joined the Village of Niles in 2013 as the Assistant Village Manager. In 2017, her position was reconfigured to encompass more responsibilities relating to the Human Resources department, accompanied by an elevation in title to Deputy Village Manager. For Thake, the promotion to Deputy Village Manager is the latest step in her career with the Village, which began in 2007 when she was hired as a part-time Clerk/Typist.

“Hadley has done a phenomenal job as Deputy Village Manager,” said Niles Mayor George D. Alpogianis, “including stepping up to go above and beyond as Acting Village Manager during the search process for Village Manager in 2021. She will be missed, and as Mayor I want to extend my sincerest thanks on behalf of the Board of Trustees. Kathy Thake has big shoes to fill, but is one of the sharpest minds in Village Hall and I know will do an excellent job for the citizens of Niles.”
