MOTOR VEHICLE CRASH

Niles, IL – On 4/26/2022, at 6:49 A.M., NPD responded to a motor vehicle crash at the intersection of Harlem Avenue and Kirk Street in Niles, IL. A Toyota Highlander being driven by a 38 year-old female collided with a Nissan Rogue being driven by 36 year-old female. The Nissan Rogue rolled onto its side as a result of the collision. The driver of the Nissan Rogue was extricated from the vehicle by Niles Fire Department personnel. Both drivers were evaluated by paramedics at the scene, and declined any further treatment. The two drivers were the sole occupants of the vehicles.

The preliminary investigation revealed the Toyota Highlander was traveling eastbound on Kirk Street and attempted to turn left to travel northbound on Harlem Avenue. The Nissan Rogue was traveling southbound on Harlem Avenue when the collision occurred.

The driver of the Toyota Highlander was cited for Failure to Yield While Turning Left, and was assigned a court date of May 23rd, 2022, 9:00 A.M., Room 103, at the Cook County District 2 courthouse in Skokie, IL.

All persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
