Niles Police Department announces distracted driving enforcement results

Niles, IL – The Niles Police Department announced it issued 127 hands-free law citations along with 8 impaired driving arrests, 18 seat belt citations, 148 speeding citations, and 253 other traffic citations during the April distracted driving enforcement period (April 1st-April 30th).

The Niles Police Department joined forces with state and local law enforcement and highway safety partners for this enforcement effort.

Using your phone in anything other than hands-free mode in Illinois is not only dangerous, but also illegal. Break the cycle. Drop it and drive.
