AGGRAVATED BATTERY ARREST

Niles, IL – On November 12, 2022, at 12:15 AM, NPD officers responded to Coca-Cola Bottling Company, 7400 N. Oak Park Avenue, Niles, for a report of a stabbing.

The investigation revealed two co-workers at the business, a 28-year-old male and 42-year-old male, had a physical altercation in the parking lot. During the altercation, the 28-year-old male produced a “Karambit” knife, which is a self-defense type knife with a curved blade. The 28-year-old male suspect then stabbed and slashed the 42-year-old victim multiple times. The victim sustained stab wounds to his forehead, hand, shoulder, and arm. Responding officers took the suspect into custody at the scene at 12:24 AM. The victim had already self-transported to nearby Niles Fire Station #3, 6611 W. Jarvis Avenue, Niles. The victim was treated by Niles paramedics at the fire station and transported to a local hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

After a subsequent investigation by NPD detectives, the Cook County State’s Attorney’s Office approved the below charge:

Suspect: Treyvon L. King, Male/28

LKA: 7400 block of South Exchange Avenue, Chicago, IL

Charge: Aggravated Battery- Deadly Weapon - 720 ILCS 5/12-3.05(f)(1) (Class 3 Felony)

The suspect attended bond court on November 13, 2022. The NPD has not had any previous contacts with the suspect.

All persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
