Niles Police Department releases Thanksgiving enforcement results

Niles, IL – The Niles Police Department conducted a traffic safety campaign Nov. 18-28 reminding motorists to buckle up and drive sober. The “Click It or Ticket” and “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over.”

Mobilization was conducted by the Niles Police Department and other state and local law enforcement agencies across Illinois to reduce highway fatalities.

During the enforcement period, the Niles Police Department took the following enforcement action:

- 22 Occupant Restraint Violations
- 15 Uninsured Motorist Violations
- 60 Speeding Violations
- 1 Felony Arrest
- 3 Suspended or Revoked Driver’s License Arrests
- 6 DUI Arrests

“Our officers patrol year-round to keep motorists buckled up and impaired drivers off the roads,” said Chief of Police, Luis C. Tigera. *“We do this to save lives and ensure all of us make it home safely at the end of the day.”*

This Thanksgiving enforcement effort is made possible by federal traffic safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation.
