RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY ARRESTS

Niles, IL –

2022-20398: On 5/21/2022, around 4:20 PM, a homeowner in the 8500 block of West Betty Terrace reported their residence had been burglarized. The front door was forced open, and the residence had been ransacked. The homeowner was unsure if anything was taken.

2022-47585: On 12/2/2022, around 3:30 PM, a homeowner in the 8100 block of North Caldwell Avenue reported their residence had been burglarized. The front door was forced open, and jewelry was taken.

Niles detectives investigated both incidents. On 12/10/2022, at 5 PM, Niles officers took three suspects into custody in the 8500 block of North Greenwood Avenue in relation to these incidents. The following charges were filed:

2022-20398:

A 17-year-old male of Chicago, IL was charged with Residential Burglary (Class 1 Felony).

2022-47585:

-AL MILLER, a 35-year-old male of the 5600 block of West Higgins Avenue, Chicago, was charged with Residential Burglary (Class 1 Felony) and Contributing to the Criminal Delinquency of a Minor (Class X Felony).

-A 16-year-old male of Chicago was charged with Residential Burglary (Class 1 Felony).

The adult suspect was transported to bond court on 12/12/2022. His bond information is not yet available. A booking photograph is attached.

All persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
