NPD Releases Enforcement Numbers for Super Bowl Traffic Enforcement Initiative

Niles, IL – The Niles Police Department has concluded its Super Bowl traffic enforcement initiative.

The Super Bowl weekend “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over” and “Click It or Ticket” enforcement effort ran from Friday, Feb. 10, through the early morning hours of Monday, Feb. 13. The goal was to keep impaired drivers off the roads and ensure more people buckle up and follow all traffic safety laws.

Throughout the campaign, the NPD took the following enforcement action.

- 7 Traffic Arrests
- 2 DUI Arrests
- 4 Occupant Restraint Citations
- 10 Speeding Citations/Warnings

“Motorists should understand that we are serious about cracking down on impaired drivers and seat belt and other traffic safety law violators. We do it to save lives,” said Luis C. Tigera, Chief of Police.
