Retail Theft

Niles, IL – On 11/14/2016 at 7:30 a.m. the CVS store employee stated that a male and female subject entered the store located at 9640 Milwaukee Avenue. They were observed removing over the counter medication from the shelf. They then concealed them inside bags they had brought with them.

When they attempted to leave the store the store employee approached them and instructed them to put the items down. The male subject then allegedly pulled out a hypodermic needle from his pants pocket, pointed it at the employee and said “you don’t want what I have.” The two offenders then left the store and entered a light colored vehicle.

Taken from the store was an estimated \$600 USC value of miscellaneous over the counter medications.

Offender # 1 is described as a Male, 5’5-5’9”, 155-175 lbs, with dark hair wearing sun glasses, dark jacket and dark pants.

Offender #2 is described as a Female, 5’5”=5-9”, 135-145 lbs, light colored hair, wearing baseball style cap, two tone colored jacket and tan colored pants.

The theft is currently under investigation.
