Armed Robbery Arrest

Niles, IL - The Niles Police Department arrested the Offender in an attempted armed robbery and aggravated battery that occurred on February 20, 2017 at about 9:30 p.m. in the parking lot located in the 8500 block of Golf road. The Offender is also wanted for a parole violation out of Kentucky. The Offender, who was intoxicated, approached two victims (male and female) and placed a knife against their throats demanding valuables while threatening their lives. The second victim decided to fight back and chased the Offender across Golf road where the subject stole a bicycle to make his getaway. One of the victims suffered a stab wound to his left shoulder during the incident.

On 2/24/2016 Niles Investigators were able to identify a potential suspect in the Armed Robbery and shared it with neighboring law enforcement agencies. At about 10:45 a.m. Officers from the Glenview Police Department checked a Motel 6 in Glenview on Milwaukee Avenue where a clerk stated he was in one of their rooms. Niles Police Investigators were notified and he was located in a motel room and taken into custody without incident.

At the Niles Police Department the Offender was interviewed and subsequently charged with attempted armed robbery, aggravated battery, unlawful use of weapon, and theft. The suspect is also being held on a nationwide extraditable parole violation warrant out of Simpson County, Kentucky.
