Aggravated Discharge of Firearm Arrest

Niles, IL - On August 17, 2017 at approximately 9:27 p.m. Officers responded to a shots fired call in the 7200 block of Greenleaf Avenue. Upon arrival Officers met the complainant who stated he heard three gun shots go off. The complainant showed the Officers surveillance video which revealed a light colored car pull onto Greenleaf from Harlem Avenue and stop just west of Harlem. The driver of the vehicle discharged a single gunshot into the air as a male passenger exited the car and continued to walk down the street. The car then continued to drive west on Greenleaf and the driver discharged two more rounds from a semi-automatic handgun. Officers conducted a search of the immediate area for both the vehicle and the passenger and were unsuccessful in locating the car or the passenger. An evidence technician processed the scene and officers conducted a neighborhood canvas.

The Niles Police Department Detective Bureau conducted an immediate follow up investigation, which resulted in the identification of a person of interest and a suspect vehicle. Detectives from the Investigation Bureau conducted surveillance near the person of interest's residence to gather additional information. On August 23, 2017 at approximately 11:30 a.m. the suspect and his vehicle were taken into custody without incident in the 10000 block of Linda Lane, Des Plaines, Illinois.

At the Niles Police Department the suspect was interviewed at the Niles Police Department and an admission was given. The Cook County State's Attorney's Office Felony Review Unit was contacted and charges were approved. The suspect was charged with one count of Reckless Discharge of a Firearm, a Class 4 Felony and one count of Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon, a Class 4 Felony. Both charges carry the potential for imprisonment for one to three years and fines up to \$25,000. The suspect will be held for a bond hearing prior to his court date on September 6, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. in room 103. All subjects are presumed innocent until found guilty in a court of law.
