Unlawful Use of a Weapon Arrest

Niles, IL – On June 3, 2018 at approximately 4:30 a.m. Niles Police Officers were dispatched to the Taco Burrito House Restaurant located at 9001 N. Milwaukee Avenue for a disturbance. Police Dispatch related that between eight and ten individuals were in the parking lot.

As the first Officer arrived on scene he observed a large crowd of people in the parking lot. The Officer immediately observed the Offender walk east in the parking lot and he appeared to be attempting to conceal what was believed to be a long black firearm, by hiding it along his torso. The Officer recognized it to be firearm from its front sight as the firearm swung back and forth. The Officer un-holstered his firearm and began giving verbal commands to the Offender to show his hands. The Offender did not immediately comply with the Officers verbal commands and continued to walk around the passenger side of his vehicle. He then placed the firearm inside the passenger side of the vehicle and closed the door to the car. The Officer continued to give verbal commands and the Offender ultimately complied, positioning himself on the ground until other Officers arrived on scene. The Offender was placed into handcuffs; he was then searched, which revealed a .40 caliber Glock magazine in his pants pocket.

Upon looking into the offender's vehicle a 2010 Audi the Officer observed a Kel-Tec Sub 2000 Rifle sitting in plain view on the front seat of the vehicle. The trunk of the vehicle was opened and upright and a box of .40 caliber ammunition was found inside.

The victims stated the original confrontation was over the offender's belief that the victim's had "cut" in line and the offender's wanted to initiate a physical confrontation inside the restaurant. The Offender was outside waiting for the victim's when they left the restaurant. The four victims were, a 25 year old, male, from Arlington Heights, a 31 year old, male, from Wheeling, a 19 year old male from Palatine and a 33 year old, male, from Palatine.

The Offender was taken into custody and after a review with the Cook County States Attorney's Office the following charges were approved.

720 ILCS 5/24.1.6-A – Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapons (Class 4 Felony) 1 – Count

720 ILCS 5/12-2-C-2 – Aggravated Assault (Class A Misdemeanor) 4 – Counts

The three other subjects with the offender were not charged, they were a 21 year old, male, from Niles, a 26 year old, male, from Niles and a 24 year old, male, from Skokie.
