Armed Robbery

Niles, IL - On April 6, 2019 at approximately 2:10 p.m. Niles Police Officers responded to the Chase Bank located at 7007 W. Dempster for an Armed Robbery. An unknown male, 40-49 years of age, wearing a light colored baseball cap, sunglasses and dark colored jacket entered the bank. The unknown male walked up to a teller handing her a note, which demanded money. The male displayed a dark colored handgun which was tucked into the waistband of his pants. The teller complied by giving money from her drawer. The Offender then exited the bank without incident. The offender entered an unknown type vehicle and fled east bound on Dempster Street. Taken was several thousand dollars.
