Residential Burglary Suspects Arrest

Niles, IL – On 6/14/2019 at approximately 9:55 p.m., Officers responded to a residential burglary just discovered by the homeowner in the 7900 block of Oketo Avenue. The homeowner reported his family had been away from the home for about four hours. When he entered his home he found it ransacked. The homeowner stated several items were taken, including jewelry valued at about \$3,000, a laptop and approximately \$700 cash. The scene was processed by an Evidence Technician.

Approximately 10:30 p.m. the NORTAF Burglary Task force conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle in Glenview. A Niles Police Department Detective detailed to the NORTAF taskforce who was aware of the burglary, observed several items inside the vehicle. A Niles Police Officer at the scene of the burglary provided details about the burglary along with a photo of suspected items taken. Inside the vehicle were the items that were reported stolen. The three suspects were taken into custody. The suspects were booked and processed pending a bond hearing.

Penalties for a Class 1 Felony if convicted are four to fifteen years in prison and /or fines up to \$25,000. Class 4 Felony if convicted is one to three years in prison and/or fines up to \$25,000. A Class A Misdemeanor carries a potential jail sentence of up to 364 days in jail and a \$2,500 fine.

All suspects are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
