Suspect charged with Armed Robbery

Niles, IL - On September 18, 2019 Detectives from the Niles Police Department charged the offender in the August 11, 2019 Armed Robbery which took place at the Walmart Store at 5630 west Touhy Avenue. The suspect was taken into custody by the Norridge Police Department subsequent to online threats that were made by the suspect towards Ridgewood High School in Norridge.

Previous to this incident in Norridge, Detectives developed information about the suspect's identity and he was positively identified by witnesses. The Cook County States Attorney's Office was contacted and a warrant for Armed Robbery was issued. On September 17, 2019 Detectives attempted to make contact with the suspect at his residence but he was not home. Detectives spoke to a family member who called him on his cellular telephone. The suspect answered his telephone but he refused to tell the detectives his location, the call ended at that time.

While detectives were looking for the suspect, the suspect made the threat against Ridgewood High School.

The suspect was charged with the Niles offense of one count of Armed Robbery with a Firearm.
